- 2 The judges' decision shall be final. When an exhibitor or exhibitor's parents, leader, or agent is guilty of unsportsmanlike conduct, the show management may suspend such exhibitor's rights to participate in future classes and/or shows for such a period as judged appropriate.
- 3. Rules from the North Carolina 4-H Horse Program Rules and Regulations Manual will be followed. USEF, AQHA, AMHR, USDF, WDAA, WHOA, rules will be followed for their respective divisions not covered in the NC 4-H Horse Program Rules and Regulations Manual.
- 4. Show management reserves the right to (a) combine, cancel or split classes depending on the number of entries, (b) change the locations(s) of classes, and (c) disqualify from showing any horse or pony that is unmanageable and dangerous or any youth who exhibits unsportsmanlike or inappropriate behavior.
- 5 Exhibitors will not be allowed to add a classes at the show.
- 6. Short Stirrup 8-12 as of January 1 Three years of participation in the division is allowed, with no more than two (2) years showing over fences. Hunter Hack does not count towards the two (2) years of over fences and may be shown all three (3) years
- Little Britches classes are for riders ages 8 12 as of Jan 1st who are in first two (2) years of showing.
- 8. Junior riders must be at least 8 on Jan 1st but have not turned 14 as of Jan 1st.
- 9. Senior riders must be at least 14 on Jan 1st but have not turned 19 as of Jan 1st.
- 10. Billy Murray (BM) Classes are non-qualifying classes for warm up and practice purposes Not open to Cloverbuds. Proceeds from entries in these classes support the Billy S. Murray Memorial Scholarship Fund of the SED4HHC.
- 11. Qualifying Points. The following point system will be used in earning qualifying points toward attending the State Show and for calculating champion and reserve awards. Each exhibitor and horse must earn one or more qualifying points in each division to be eligible to participate in that division in the State Show. The number of horses in a class will be determined by the number actually shown. Under no circumstances shall a disqualified contestant receive points; however, each horse brought into the ring will constitute an entry and will be counted.

I do hereby agree to allow my child to be photographed, audio or videotaped by the Program. I further agree that my child's i mage or likeness in photographs, videos, or audio may be used for educational or promotional purposes, including posting on the Internet. I agree that the use herein may be without compensation to me or my child. I hereby waive any right to inspect or approve the finished electronic, photograph, or printed matter that may be used in conjunction with them now or in the future. I am expressly releasing NC State, its agents, employees, licensees and assigns from any and all claims which I may have for invasion of my or my child's privacy, right of publicity, defamation, copyright infringement, or any other causes of action arising out of the use, adaptation, reproduction, distribution, broadcast or exhibition of such recordings.

I understand that this is a legal document which is binding on me, my heirs and assigns and on those who may claim by or through me. I am eighteen years of age or older, and have full capacity to enter into this agreement and do so voluntarily.
