Horse Bowl and Hippology Results

On March 9, 2019, N.C. 4-H Hippology and Horsebowl contests were held at NC State University. 229 youth competed in four different divisions for this year's hippology contest. 58 juniors and 31 seniors competed in the inaugural "Rookie" division. 70 junior individuals and 14 teams, and 70 senior individuals and 13 teams battled for Horseman of the Year and champion team honors.

In the state Horsebowl contest, 12 teams in each category, Junior, Senior, and Mixed, went head to head in the double-elimination competition to determine the state winners. High scoring individuals in each division were also recognized for their outstanding performances in their high 3 rounds.

2019 4-H/FFA Horse Judging Contest

The annual Horse Judging contest will be held on April 13, 2019 at Martin Community College in Williamston, NC. Online entries are due April 2, 2019. New for 2019 is the Rookie division for Juniors and Seniors that have never competed in horse judging! Cloverbuds are also invited to participate.

The Horse Judging Contest is designed to teach participants good conformation (structural correctness, balance, and muscling), breed character, and performance ideals in different breeds of horses. Additionally, the Horse Judging contest will teach participants how to evaluate horses based on knowledge and fact, make a decision, and defend it. The Contest will teach participants horsemanship terms that can be used in a logical, systematic way to defend placings and will help participants gain confidence in their ability and use of the English language by giving oral reasons to a judge while learning to speak clearly, decisively, and convincingly through the use of oral reasons.


